2021 Gap's Crown Vineyard Pinot Noir

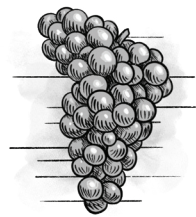
A Vineyard Made for Pinot Noir

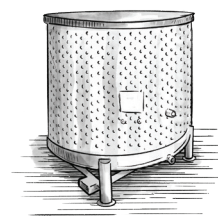
The 2021 vintage of Gap's Crown Vineyard Pinot Noir comprises four carefully selected clones and underwent fermentation in a combination of stainless steel, concrete, and wood vessels. This wine possesses a magical quality—its consistent excellence year after year is a testament to its unwavering nature.

This vintage captivates the senses with sophisticated notes of crushed raspberry and delicate lemon blossom with savory undertones of fennel and sage. Well-balanced with lively acidity, it gracefully envelops the palate, leaving a lingering and memorable finish.

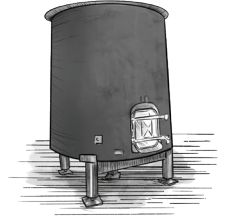
Fact of Note: There were five harvest picks that spanned one month.

FERMENTATION 41% stainless steel, 34% wood, 25% concrete, 6% whole cluster

ÉLEVAGE 41% new French oak for 17 months, 2% new Austrian oak for 17 months, prior to bottling 100% stainless steel for 1 month

ALCOHOL 14.1%

pH 3.63

TA 5.86 g/L

TASTING NOTES

NOSE Sophisticated and enticing with a bouquet of vibrant pomegranate, sage, and a hint of lemon blossom.

MOUTH The sleek texture is balanced by medium acidity, highlighting red fruit flavors and a refreshing trace of herbs—a classic Gap's Crown Vineyard expression.
