Sonoma-Cutrer marries Californian innovation with Burgundian tradition to capture the essence of Sonoma County, its people and its land. We demonstrate our unwavering commitment to consistency and dedication to showcasing Sonoma County's unique terroir in each wine, highlighting the region's distinct foggy, coastal and cool climate. Since our founding in 1973 and the release of our first wine in 1981, Sonoma-Cutrer has grown to become one of the largest luxury Chardonnay brands in the U.S. retail market and among the fastest-growing brands within its category. Sonoma-Cutrer is passionate about sustainability. All six of our estate vineyards, spanning 1,121 acres across the Russian River Valley and Sonoma Coast appellations, have earned the Sonoma County Sustainability certification through the California Sustainable Winegrowing Alliance.

Driven by a deep commitment to sustainable winemaking and helmed by Director of Winemaking Cara Morrison, Sonoma-Cutrer integrates certified practices like California Sustainable Winegrowing and Fish Friendly Farming. We conserve water by converting over half of our frost protection to fan-based systems and recycle all treated wastewater for vineyard irrigation. Through initiatives such as owl boxes for natural pest control and cover crops for beneficial insects, we support biodiversity and enhance soil health. Recycling and composting are essential parts of our operations, reducing landfill waste. Sustainability isn't just a responsibility—it's our passion, shaping every choice we make to protect and preserve our cherished land.

Sonoma-Cutrer boasts six wholesale wines including four award-winning Chardonnays—Sonoma Coast, The Cutrer, Les Pierres and Russian River Ranches—as well as the Russian River Valley Pinot Noir and Russian River Valley Rosé of Pinot Noir.
